All Pathways are designed to transfer to a four-year institution for eventual completion of a BA/BS degree.

A graduate with a degree in construction management typically will plan, direct, coordinate, and budget a wide variety of construction projects, including the building of all types of residential, commercial, and industrial structures, roads, bridges, wastewater treatment plants, and schools and hospitals. Graduates in construction management may work in professions such as residential or commercial construction manager, inspector, estimator, field engineer or general contractor.
